A guide to Without Prejudice Visits

We like parents and carers to visit Morecambe Road School. It is good for children to know that their parents are interested in their school and education. We believe that the best team consists of the child, the parents, the local authority and the staff, working together.

A Without Prejudice Visit can be determined through a variety of initiators:

- ✓ As a request by the Local Authority's Special Education Needs and Disability Officer (SENDO).
- ✓ As a suggestion or further action recorded in the child's Annual Review.
- ✓ In preparation for key transition times (Nursery into Primary & Primary into Secondary).
- ✓ Advice from other professionals as to the suitability of educational placement.

Parents are welcome to visit the school at any time (although telephoning beforehand to make an appointment is required and much appreciated). A member of the Senior Leadership Team will meet with you and take you on a tour of our school and we will discuss with you how we present the curriculum to our pupils.

The visit is **not an offer** of a place within our school and any decisions will be determined by the Local Authority Special Education Needs and Disability Officer. We feel it is important to include your child as part of this process and if you feel it is appropriate, would welcome the chance to meet them on the visit. We may ask you to attend a further visit if you do not feel it is appropriate for them to attend the initial WPV.
